BIOGRAPHY

Lyu Pinchang studied at Jingdezhen Ceramic University before pursuing advanced studies at the China Academy of Art and completing his doctorate at the Central Academy of Fine Arts, where he obtained his Master's degree in 1988.

He is currently President of the Jiangxi Provincial Artists Association and a specially appointed professor and doctoral supervisor at the Central Academy of Fine Arts. He holds numerous leadership roles across China's arts and cultural institutions, including Director of the Public Art Committee of the China Artists Association, Vice Chairman of the China Sculptors Association, Chairman of the Ceramics Professional Committee of the China Intangible Cultural Heritage Association, and rotating Chairman of the Belt and Road International Ceramics Education Alliance. He is also a member of the UNESCO International Academy of Ceramics (IAC). Since 1993, he has received a Special Government Allowance from the State Council, and has been selected as part of the Ministry of Education's New Century Excellent Talents programme.

Over the course of his career, Lyu Pinchang has accumulated more than 20 major awards, including the National Outstanding Teacher Medal awarded jointly by the Ministry of Personnel and the Ministry of Education, the Gold Award at the 3rd National Sports Art Exhibition of the China Artists Association, the Special Prize at the 4th China Fine Arts Award presented by the Central Propaganda Department and the China Federation of Literary and Art Circles in 2024, and the Outstanding Contribution Award at the 90th Anniversary of Sculpture at the Central Academy of Fine Arts. He has also received a second-class National Teaching Achievement Award from the Ministry of Education and led the team recognised as a national Huang Dalian-style Teaching Team in 2023.
